Shri Swapnil Ganguly prays for three days' time to file the report as directed by this Court on 26.3.2015. Representative appearing for the petitioner submitted that inspite of repeated opportunities being given and inspite of order passed on 26.3.2015, the State Government has not filed the report.

We give three days' time as a matter of last indulgence to the State Government to file the report on or before 27th of April, 2015 with a copy to all concerned, failing which, we may consider taking coercive steps in the matter which may include stopping of the mining activities in the area.

That apart, copy of the enquiry report and other documents be supplied not only to the petitioner but also to the counsel for the remaining respondents, so that they may file counter affidavit to the same if any.

In the meanwhile, the learned Assistant Solicitor General representing the Union of India and the Ministry of Forest and Environment and the Standing Counsel representing the Pollution Control Board in the Principal Seat at Jabalpur be noticed by the Registry with regard to transfer of members of the Indore Bench for listing of the case and their names be reflected in the cause list as and when the case is listed.

List the matter on **6th of May, 2015**.
